In Science we will learn about:

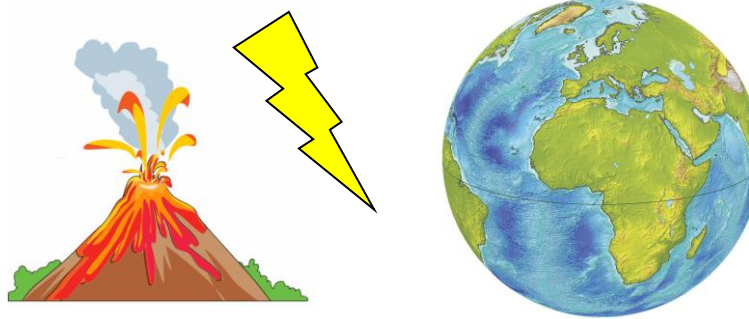
Investigate different materials and their uses, as well as planning experiments to test different hypothesis.

**In PE we will learn about:**
