In English we will learn about:

As writers we will be:

Writing a story inspired by the animated short film, Alma. Identifying features of non-fiction writing and writing reports about Ancient Greece.

Exploring myths and legends of Greek mythology. Alongside this we will be continuing to build on our grammatical knowledge and immersing ourselves in the reading and enjoyment of a wide variety of texts.

In Maths we will learn about:

Place Value: Numbers up to 10,000,000.

Arithmetic: Column addition, subtraction, formal methods of written division and multiplication, adding, subtracting,

dividing and multiplying fractions.

Geometry: Properties of shapes and position and direction

as well as angle properties.

In Art and DT we will learn about:

In Music we will learn about:

In Computing we will learn about:
