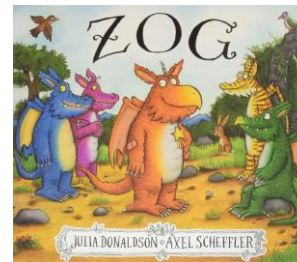


In Maths we will learn about:
