It is so good to have our school full of happy smiling children again, thank you again for your continuing support. With Easter fast approaching, the time is coming where you may be starting to make plans, can we just remind you to read up on the current restrictions for you area.

<u>From 29 March</u>, when most schools start to break up for the Easter holidays, outdoor gatherings of either 6 people or 2 households will be allowed, making it easier for friends and families to meet outside only. <u>The evidence shows that it is safer for people to meet outdoors rather than indoors.</u> Refer to: <a href="https://www.gov.uk/coronavirus">https://www.gov.uk/coronavirus</a> for further details.

## Important Reminder

We must <u>urge</u> you to continue to follow social distancing guidelines, when dropping off and collecting your child/children.

We continue to work tirelessly to minimise risks, therefore please remember to <u>wear face masks</u> whilst on school premises, and the <u>2 metre physical distance</u> guidance; which needs to be taken seriously. <u>We have markings on the playgrounds to help you with this.</u>

You <u>must</u> maintain this **2 metre distance** when dropping off and collecting your child/children and avoid making close contact with others outside of your household, support or childcare bubble. This includes adults and children mixing together on the playground before and after school.

We take great care to ensure bubbles do not come into contact with one another during the school day and would appreciate your support in continuing this on the playgrounds before and after school.







#### Homework

A reminder that homework will be set on Seesaw, each week. Please make sure you have your child's log in details to hand. Reading books will remain on Oxford Owls as we are still unable to send books home. It is important homework is completed on time, if you have any problems accessing or completing it, please contact school.




#### Positive test result?

If a member of your family tests positive and your child is currently attending school, you must **not** send your child to school and inform us of the positive result as soon as possible. This enables us to follow track and trace procedures and isolate bubbles where needed.

Isolation stops transmission, therefore ultimately prevents losing lives to Covid-19.

To reiterate, if there is a positive result in the family home, do not send your child to school and inform us that they are isolating due to a positive result in the family.
