



Mindfulness

It has been really interesting to learn just how many young people have been taking part in mindfulness type activities, such as yoga, throughout lockdown. Following some research, we have found lots of free resources online as well as a local 'kid's yoga' online class. Please see below the list of resources as well as details of the local class.

Mindfulness involves sitting silently and paying attention to thoughts, sounds, the sensations of breathing or parts of the body, bringing your attention back whenever the mind starts to wander. Yoga and tai-chi can also help with developing awareness of your breathing.

Benefits of Mindfulness

- Strengthens self-control.
- Lower's anxiety and stress.
- Increases positive moods.
- Better equipped to cope with change and other stressors.
- Have better sleep habits.
- Feel more connected to the people around them.
- Better decision making.
- Improves Emotional Regulation Skills.
- Increases self-esteem.
- Improves social skills and communication.
- Experience less sadness.
