In Maths we will learn about:

- *Multiplication Tables
- * Written and Mental Multiplication
- * Written and Mental Division
- *Measures Time
- *Geometry -3D Shape
- *Addition and Subtraction
- *Number Facts

In Computing we will learn about: We will be using our laptops to use the software Scratch to learn how to computer programming! Eventually, the children will make a small computer game.

In PE we will learn about:

Gymnastics/Net & Wall Games - We will be practicing our balancing skills, then learning net & wall skills.

In Forest School: we will be exploring the outdoors and learning about nature.

In Music we will be using: Glockenspiels and practicing how to find the beat during a song.

In Science we will learn about:

Light and Dark - Children will use their scientific investigation skills to learn about light and dark and how they work to help us see. We will explore reflection and shadows.

In PSHE we will be learning about:

We will be learning about healthy eating and exercise and setting ourselves goals to complete.

In Geography we will learn about:

We will be learning about the Stone Age and Skara Brae where we will explore where they lived using map work.

Other activities will include:
