### Communication and Language:

We will be developing our understanding and language of size. We will learn all about positional language and the language of measure including heavy and light, long and short and tall and short.


We will continue to practise **counting from 0-20** backwards and forwards as well as understanding the values of these numbers and how to write numbers accurately.


### In RE we will learn about:

Why was Jesus a special baby?


**Literacy:** We will be exploring the story of Kipper's Birthday and other books related to celebrations including Christmas, Bonfire night and Diwali.
